


MAP FROM HOBART:




DIRECTIONS:

Travelling North from Hobart:

1. Follow the A3 Tasman Highway towards the Tasman Bridge and follow the signs for Sorell.
2. At Sorell turn left at the T-junction following the signs for Orford on the A3 Tasman Highway.
3. After 35km you will reach the town of Buckland.
4. Continue through Buckland and carry on North. An overtaking lane starts just after Buckland and the highway here is very straight. 500m after this finishes, Brockley Road is on your left, just before the straight finishes and the highway curves to the right. There is a blue and yellow tourist sign telling you where to turn.
5. Turn into Brockley Road, and follow this for 1.6km and turn right when you see the sign saying 'Brockley Estate Homestead'.
6. Continue straight until you reach 3 gates - take the middle green iron gate and carry on to park in front of the house.

MAP FROM LAUNCESTON:



Travelling South from Launceston:

There are several ways to get to Brockley from Launceston: via Lake Leake and the East Coast, via Richmond or via the back roads from Oatlands if you fancy an interesting drive with a small section of gravel road. Below are the directions via Lake Leake (the least interesting road but the easiest).

1. Travelling South on the Midlands Highway, turn left onto the Lake Leake Highway B34 – sign-posted Bicheno.
2. Follow the B34 for about 57km until you reach the junction with the A3 Tasman Highway and follow the signs for Swansea/Sorell/Hobart.
3. Continue South on the A3 Tasman Highway.
4. At Orford continue driving South on the A3 Tasman Highway for 11km.
5. After you cross a small river called ‘Tea Tree Rivulet, Brockley Road will be on your right. There is a blue and yellow tourist sign telling you where to turn. If you reach the overtaking lane, you have missed the junction and will need to turn around.
6. Turn into Brockley Road, and follow this for 1.6km and turn right when you see the sign saying ‘Brockley Estate Homestead’.
7. Continue straight until you reach 3 gates - take the middle green iron gate and carry on to park in front of the house.
